2008 OCTA report:

- Pre-registration for the conference *How Sweet It Is* \$95 (before August 8) or \$115 (after August 8) and includes 2 meals, excerpts, regular workshops and entertainment. Deadline is August 15th, registration at the door is \$115 and does not include meals. Daily registration (Sat. or Sun. only) is \$55 (before August 8) or \$60 (after August 8)-no meals. Forms available are available on the OCTA website.
- Delegate meeting to caucus and vote is Sunday at 12:15pm.
- OCTA has 6 (3 year term) positions on its governing board open for election at its annual conference. Successful candidates are energetic advocates of theatre who enjoy working with other enthusiasts to serve and promote community theatre in Ohio. - The date for the 2009 Regional's has been changed to either the 5th or 12th of July in 2009.
- Ohio's AACT festival will be February 14th and 15th, 2009 in Columbus.
