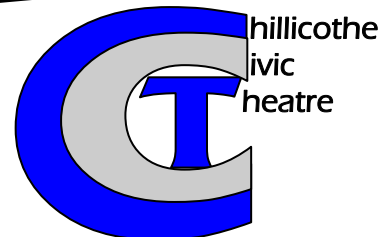

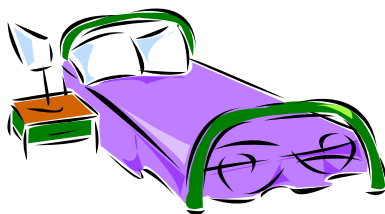
RIGHT BED, WRONG HUSBAND
