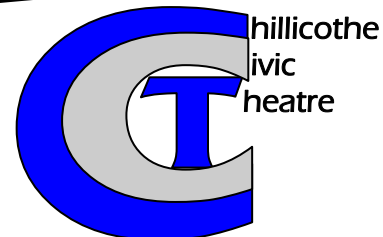

A first time director with CCT, Amanda Betz, is doing a wonderful job in pulling this show together. She is ably assisted by Connie Senter, a CCT veteran and member of our Board. They have assembled a terrific cast of around 20 children and about 10 adults. It is an amazing undertaking and should prove to be a wonderful experience for all - cast, crew, and attendees alike. All seats for our three performances are reserved seating only. This means that there is no general seating; each ticket is for a specific seat in the theatre. You may reserved seats by visiting our website at <http://cct.kennardweb.net>, emailing cct@kennardweb.net, or by calling Tim

Kennard at 775-6896. Ticket reservations must be paid for by December 8th, even if the tickets are being picked up at the door. Any seats reserved prior to the first performance, but not paid for, will be returned to the ticket pool for sale at the door. Ticket prices are as follows:

- Adults\$10
- Students/Senior Citizens 60+\$8
- Children 12 & under\$5

Patrons with complimentary tickets need to reserve their seats as well. We expect performances to fill up fast, so don't delay in arranging for your tickets as soon as possible. ■

Auditions will be held at the St. Peter's Church Auxiliary Hall on W. Water St. (just behind the church)

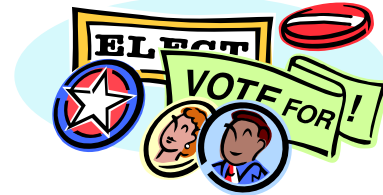
Enter from the door on the walkway between the buildings.

All acts must be performance ready. You must bring a Karaoke CD to sing with or provide your own accompanist, if you are singing. Please make sure your act is appropriate to the holiday season. Lip sync acts are not eligible.

If chosen for the show, you must attend a dress rehearsal to coordinate with the sound and lighting crews. You will be informed of the time and other details once chosen.■
